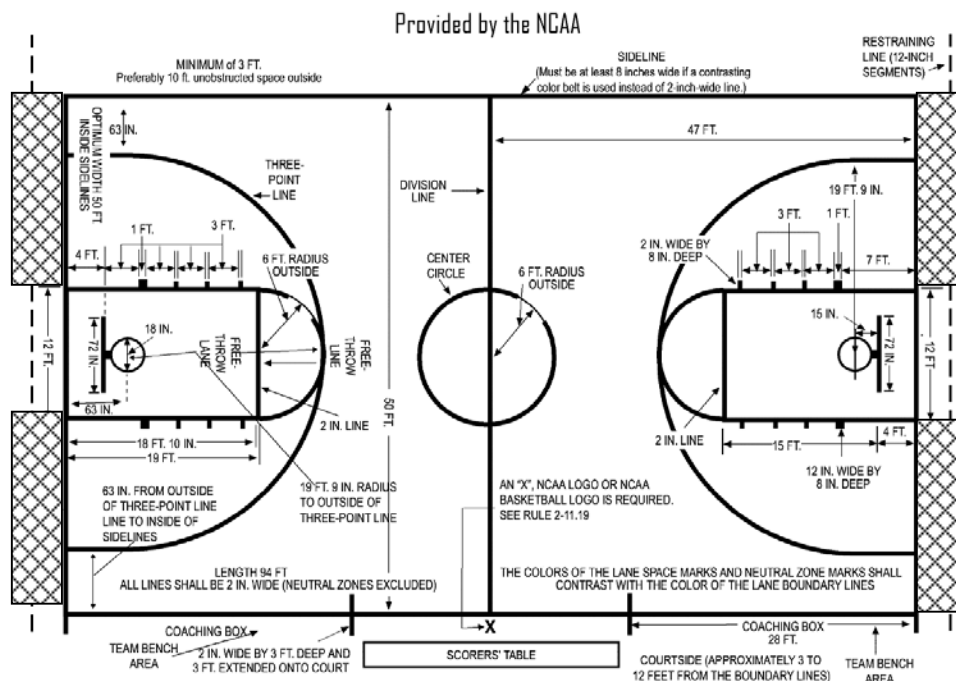


Dec 22, Wednesday. NCAA Basketball at Iona College (limited to 5 participants)

This field trip provides an opportunity for WPS photographers to obtain photographer credentials from Iona College for courtside access to the NCAA Division I women's basketball game between Iona College and Fordham University at 5:00 pm followed by a men's basketball games between Iona College and The University of Vermont at 7:30 pm. Photographers will be shooting from the areas indicated with crosshatching, below. Photographers will retain the rights to all images but will be expected to share rights for selected images with the Iona College Athletics Department.



Shooting guidelines:

- Flash is not permitted at courtside
- Preferred lenses: In the range of 17-70 mm, with maximum apertures of 2.8 or less
Canon 85mm f/1.8, Canon 17-55mm f/2.8 IS, Nikon 85mm f/1.4, Nikon 24-70mm f/2.8
A 70-200mm f/2.8 can be used occasionally for shooting across the court
- Preferred Shutter Speed: 1/500 sec is minimum, 1/800 or 1/1000 is preferable
- Preferred Body: Camera should be capable of shooting at ISO 1600 or 3200 with minimal noise and with a continuous servo Autofocus with

Gametime: Plan to arrive no later than 45 minutes prior to game time to get camera settings established..

Parking: If you are coming just for the games, enter the front gate on North Avenue and park in the garage adjacent to the sports facility. The guard can direct you. If you are attending the microscopy session in the morning, follow those separate parking directions. Prior Registration is Required/ Participation is limited.
