## **Understandiing and Using Speedlights**

Lester will demystify flash technique by providing a overview of the aesthetics and mechanics of cameramounted (and off-camera) speedlight flash photography, and prove that flash images can look excellent. Numerous slides and demonstrations will cover the various flash "looks;" the modes (automatic, manual, TTL dedicated); and techniques: bounce, fill-in, multiple flash with slaves, and appropriate accessories (including one small umbrella for a great little portrait studio). Lester will also discuss the close integration between modern digital cameras and flash, and the wonderful balance between ambient light and flash that's possible.

Lester Lefkowitz has been a professional photographer and teacher for over thirty years. His work has appeared in *National Geographic*, The New York *Times*, *Time* Magazine, and hundreds of other U.S. and international publications. He has photographed in all fifty states, twenty-one countries and Antarctica. Lester is an engaging, enthusiastic teacher, and has taught scores of workshops at the International Center of Photography in New York City, lectured to numerous professional organizations, and annually teaches workshop in Italy. He is also the author of three books on photography, established the undergraduate art photography program at Stony Brook University, and holds a master's degree in optical engineering.
