**Disruptions of Judging: Challenges to a Fair Photography Contest & Tests for Personal Growth**



### ***Topic***

*The Vulnerabilities of Being An Artistic Magistrate.* *What a Judge Looks For* is only a portion of the whole concept of Judging so shouldn't be written as being the main or only focus. It goes into the broader context of judging and contests. I approach it from an angle just to make it interesting and provocative, and that is, what are the dangers of judging and judges' biases?
