Topic Description

What gets your blood boiling (why do you do photography?) How can you express that passion in your images? This talk will be a slice of a workshop that Jim runs on this topic, and it will (1) make the case for improving images using Photoshop, and (2) show you some new ways to do it. You'll also get links to online, step-by-step instructional videos and downloadable examples so you make the techniques part of your image-making toolkit.

Bio

Jim Christensen (NY) is a photographer, teacher, and speaker from the New York City area; a past president of the Westchester Photographic Society; founder of the Photographers of Northern Westchester; and was the Artist in Residence at Acadia National Park in the spring of 2015. He has a deep technical background in digital imaging theory and software as a result of his career as a research scientist at IBM where he created firmware and image processing software for one of the world's best (and first) digital colorimetric cameras (in the 1980's and 1990's).
