

Gillian Greenhill Hannum is Professor of Art History at Manhattanville College in Purchase, New York, where she has been on the faculty since 1987. A photohistorian with MA and PhD degrees from The Pennsylvania State University, she has published on photographic topics in the *Journal of the Royal Photographic Society* (of Great Britain), *History of Photography* and *Nineteenth Century*. She is also a Fellow of the Royal Photographic Society of Great Britain. She teaches courses in the history of photography, American art and modern art. She was co-curator of the exhibition “Eva Watson-Schütze: Pictorialist Portraits” at the Palmer Museum of Art, Pennsylvania State University (January – April 2017).
